## Agricultural Equipment Technician: Trade Related Skills

- Uses hoisting and lifting equipment
- Uses Personal Protective Equipment and Safety Equipment
- Maintain fluids
- Services fasteners, sealing devices, adhesives, and gaskets
- Services hoses, tubing, piping, and fittings
- Services bearings and seals
- Performs scheduled maintenance procedures
- Performs pre-operational check
- Communicates with others
- Maintains safe work environment
- Heats, cools, and cuts material
- Repairs components related to undercarriage systems
- Identifies operational faults
- Prepares job action plan
- Diagnoses brake systems and wheel assemblies
- Reads diagnostic trouble codes
