## Automotive Refinishing Technician: Trade Related Skills

- Interprets vehicle information, technical manuals, and bulletins
- Interprets safety and environmental regulations
- Contributes to development of repair estimates and interprets work orders
- Uses computer and measuring equipment
- Uses and maintains hand tools and power tools
- Communicates with others
- Organizes materials and performs inspections of tasks listed in repair estimate
- Performs initial preparation (cleaning of vehicle, removing trim and accessories)
- Repairs imperfections, masks vehicle, strips surfaces, and sands surfaces
- Applies fillers, primers, primer surfacers and chip guard
- Performs final sanding
- Prepares equipment (spray gun and spray booth)
- Mixes paint and performs color matching / Applies sealers and topcoat materials
- Maintains spray booth and spray equipment
- Accesses detailing requirements, removes surface imperfections and masking material
- Installs trim and accessories
- Applies decals, striping, and anti-corrosive material
- Cleans interior and hard surfaces
