Automotive Service Technician (PRB): Trade Related Skills (2019)

- Uses tools, equipment, fasteners, tubing, hoses, and fittings
- Uses hoisting and lifting equipment
- Uses technical information and communication techniques
- Diagnoses and repairs drive shafts and axles
- Diagnoses and repairs basic wiring and electrical systems
- Diagnoses, removes, and replaces batteries
- Diagnoses and repairs conventional steering systems
- Diagnoses and repairs conventional suspension systems
- Diagnoses and repairs non-ABS braking systems
- Diagnoses and repairs tires, wheels, hubs, and wheel bearings
- Diagnoses and repairs wind noises, rattles, and water lakes
- Diagnoses and repairs interior and exterior components, accessories, and trim
- Diagnoses and repairs latches, locks and movable glass
- Diagnoses and repairs cooling and lubricating systems
- Diagnoses manual transmissions/transaxles
- Diagnoses and repairs starting/charging systems
- Diagnoses and repairs clutches
