Automotive Service Technician (Steering Suspension and Brakes): Trade Related Skills

- Recognizes shop hazards and practices safe work habits
- Maintains safe and orderly work environment
- Handles and stores hazardous materials according to WHMIS
- Performs preliminary diagnosis
- Road tests the vehicle
- Locates and follows maintenance and repair procedures from service manual
- Performs proper work order documentation
- Uses common shop tools, mechanical hand tools, and equipment
- Selects, uses and maintains measuring devices and gauges
- Uses automotive fasteners, tubing, and fittings
- Uses oxy-fuel equipment
- Uses GMAW (MIG) equipment
- Inspects, cleans, tests, and replaces lead/acid batteries, belts, and hoses
- Inspects and changes engine, transmission, and differential fluids and filters
- Services wheels and tires
