Bricklayer: Trade Related Skills

- Maintains safe work environment
- Maintains tools and equipment
- Plans daily tasks and activities
- Dismantles scaffolding
- Uses mortar, concrete and grout
- Installs insulation, membrane, and flashing
- Uses adhesives
- Disassembles unit masonry
- Removed deteriorated components
- Damp cures walls
- Cleans existing masonry surfaces
- Seals masonry surfaces
- Lays out walls and coursing
- Applies anchoring/tie systems
- Uses personal protective equipment and safety equipment
