Please be sure to obtain a copy of your NBTAP Logbook from your School Champion or the Pre-Apprenticeship Coordinator PRIOR to starting your employment placement.



## Carpenter: Trade Related Skills

- Uses and maintains power and pneumatic tools
- Uses lifting, rigging, and hoisting equipment
- Uses personal protective equipment and safety equipment
- Maintains safe work environment
- Installs fasteners, adhesives, and connectors
- Uses stationary access equipment
- Organizes materials
- Uses safety documentation to employ safe work procedures
- Lays out floor, deck, wall, and ceiling systems
- Constructs footing forms
- Dismantles formwork
- Places and protects concrete and performs basic concrete finishing
- Installs engineered floor systems
- Constructs dimensional lumber floor framing
- Constructs decks and installs components
- Uses layout instruments
- Installs membranes and sealants
