Commercial Trailer Technician: Trade Related Skills

- Demonstrates safe working practices and techniques
- Inspects trailer systems
- Interprets information in manufacturers' service manuals and related service materials
- Specifies and Services Hand, Cutting and Power Tools
- Employs and maintains shop equipment
- Employs and maintains dimensional measuring devices
- Operates and maintains oxyacetylene welding equipment
- Operates and maintains standard arc welding equipment
- Operates and maintains metal inert gas (MIG) welding equipment
- Inserts fastening and seating devices, wires, and connectors
- Isolates electrical/electronic system faults
- Compiles with government and company policies and procedures, guidelines and standards
- Services slider and fixed suspension and air suspension systems
- Services braking, air, and anti-lock braking systems (ABS)
- Services axles and wheel hubs
- Services tires and wheel rims
- Services coupling units, such as fifth wheel, turn table, and hitches
