Construction Craftworker: Trade Related Skills

- Uses personal protective equipment
- Maintains safe work environment
- Selects and uses rigging, hoisting, and lifting equipment
- Uses and maintains power-actuated tools
- Uses and maintains stations equipment (water pumps, heaters, generators)
- Monitors moving parts of stationary equipment
- Uses communication equipment (radios, cell phones, and plant phones)
- Guide equipment (hoisting equipment, skid steers, and excavators)
- Selects and stores tools and equipment
- Measures, modifies, and places rebar cage in pile holes
- Performs hand excavation around underground utilities
- Assists in installation of piling
- Cuts, secures, sprays on, and tapes insulating materials
- Properly disposes of waste, cleaning products and hazardous materials
- Installs membranes (polyethylene, waterproofing membrane, and landscaping fabric)
- Set-ups, maintains, positions, and connects generators and compressors
- Inspects and monitors heaters
