## Construction Electrician: Trade Related Skills

- Uses personal protective equipment
- Maintains safe work environment
- Performs lock-out and tag-out procedures
- Uses tools and equipment and access equipment
- Uses hoisting and lifting equipment
- Organizes materials and supplies
- Plans project tasks and procedures
- Prepares worksite
- Fabricates support structures
- Installs brackets, hangers, and fasteners
- Uses communication techniques
- Installs single-phase consumer/supper services
- Installs grounding and bonding systems
- Installs conductors, cables, conduit, tubing, and fittings
- Installs raceways, wiring devices, and luminaries
- Installs boxes and enclosures
- Performs servicing and maintenance of raceways, cables, and enclosures
