Instrumentation and Control Technician: Trade Related Skills

- Maintains safe work environment and uses personal protective equipment
- Uses diagrams, drawings, and schematics
- Performs de-energizing, lock-out, and tag-out procedures
- Maintains calibration, configuration, and test equipment
- Maintains tools and documentation
- Operates material handling equipment
- Installs and maintains pressure devices
- Repairs electrical equipment (cabling, conduit, on/off control device, fuses, batteries, etc.)
- Installs and maintains electrical equipment (cabling, conduit, on/off control devices, fuses, batteries, etc.)
- Installs and maintains temperature, level, and flow devices
- Diagnoses pressure, temperature, level, and flow devices
- Diagnoses control devices and hydraulic systems
