

# NBTAP Secondary Pre-Apprenticeship



Over the course of the NBTAP Employment experience, student apprentices should observe, and perform, some of the following trade skills under the supervision of a qualified journeyman.

## Insulator (Heat and Frost): Trade Related Skills

- Uses personal protective equipment and safety equipment
- Maintains safe work environment
- Uses tools and equipment
- Uses access equipment
- Uses communication techniques and organizes materials on site
- Installs insulation on plumbing and mechanical piping systems
- Applies vapour barriers on insulated plumbing and mechanical piping systems
- Performs task scheduling
- Applies fireproofing to architectural, structural, mechanical and electrical components
- Determines required PPE for asbestos abatement
- Retrieves sample of asbestos for testing
- Determines scope of work
- Prepares site for removal and containment of asbestos
- Builds temporary enclosure (asbestos)
- Removes, disposes, encapsulates, and encloses asbestos
- Performs decontamination of area and equipment (asbestos)
- Performs lead abatement and mold remediation
- Installs acoustic panels to ceilings and walls
