Iron Worker (Generalist): Trade Related Skills

- Demonstrates safe work habits
- Maintains and operates SMAW equipment
- Applies OHS, WHMIS and other safety related regulations
- Inspects, maintains, and uses personal protective equipment
- Communicates with co-workers to warn of hazards
- Inspects, installs and secures platforms, ladders and working surfaces
- Uses and maintains hand tools, power tools, and powder actuated tools
- Operates and maintains oxy-fuel equipment safety to produce accurate cuts and adequate welds
- Inspects, installs, and secures platforms and ladders
- Establishes hand, voice and radio communications with co-workers
- Demonstrate the ability to work at heights
- Performs tasks safety and effectively
- Reads and interprets specifications and structural, mechanical, and architectural blueprints, diagrams, and details
- Identifies, selects, and assembles rigging equipment and tools in preparation for lifting, moving, and placing of load
- Identifies knots, hitches, and bends
- Demonstrates ability to tie off material and equipment
