Iron Worker (Structural/Ornamental): Trade Related Skills

- Demonstrates Safe Work Habits
- Inspects personal protective equipment
- Installs reinforcing concrete materials and decking
- Demonstrates the ability to work from heights, while performing tasks safely and effectively
- Identifies knots, hitches, and bends
- Maintains and operates SMAW equipment
- Uses and maintains hand tools, power tools, and powder actuated tools
- Demonstrates ability to tie-off material and equipment
- Establishes hand, voice, and radio communications
- Checks condition of anchor bolts and embedded parts, and cleans and prepares for assembly
- Fits, tacks, and braces materials using SMAW equipment to set and assemble components
- Inspects, installs, and secures platforms, ladders and working surfaces
- Prepares materials for installation by cleaning, straightening, welding, cutting, drilling, grinding, and attaching sub-assemblies as required by blueprints and specifications
