## Lather Interior Systems Technician: Trade Related Skills

- Build and dismantle hoardings
- Installs wood and metal backing
- Layout degree angles
- Performs hand signals
- Maintains safe work environment
- Handles materials, supplies, and products
- Uses and maintains hand and portable power tools
- Operates and maintains machines and equipment
- Assembles, dismantles, and erects scaffolding, rigging and hoisting equipment
- Uses and maintains powder-actuates and gas-actuated tools
- Builds, installs, and secures temporary access structures
- Builds, installs, jigs, and templates for bulkheads
- Uses personal protective equipment and safety equipment
- Layout non-load bearing walls and suspended ceilings
- Reads and interprets blueprints, specifications, and other documents
- Frames non-load bearing steel assemblies, such as walls and ceilings
- Uses and applies fasteners, connectors, and adhesives
