Mobile Hoisting Equipment Operator: Trade Related Skills

- Follows laws and safety regulations and safe rigging procedures
- Utilizes personal protective equipment and applies first aid
- Assesses site hazards
- Safely operations fire extinguishing equipment of hoisting equipment
- Communicates with others and completes written communication
- Performs pre-operational checks, continual checks, regular interval inspections, and minor repairs (non-structural)
- Inspects and maintains slings and hardware
- Determines load weights and rigging requirements
- Participates in engineered and specialty lift planning
- Prepares the site and positions the crane
- Confirms lift procedures with site personnel
- Relocates crane on site and secures crane
- Prepares cranes for transport
- Drives cranes on public and private roadways
- Assembles and disassembles specialty equipment and attachments
- Operates knuckle boom trucks
