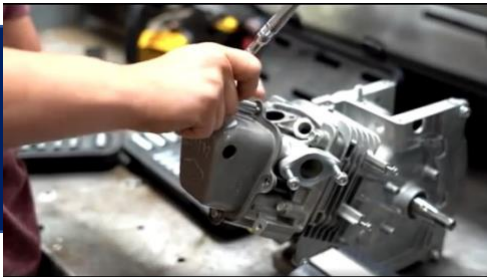


NBTAP Secondary Pre-Apprenticeship

Recreation Vehicle Service Technician: Trade Related Skills

- Demonstrates safe work practices
- Utilizes drawings, codes, standards, and service manuals
- Utilizes tools and measuring equipment
- Demonstrates common work practices and procedures
- Provides customer service
- Maintains portable water and wastewater systems
- Maintains safe condition and temperature of finished products
- Maintains AC and DC electrical systems
- Maintains high- and low-pressure LP gas systems
- Maintains furnaces and associated systems
- Maintains water heaters
- Maintains ranges and ovens
- Maintains air conditioning and heat pump systems
- Maintains interior and exterior components
- Maintains undercarriage components and towed vehicles
- Maintain braking systems
- Performs accessories/systems installations
