Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Technician: Trade Related Skills

- Demonstrates safe work practices in the workplace
- Selects, uses, and maintains personal protective equipment and safety equipment
- Select and safely uses fall protection equipment and fall protection systems
- Applies lockout and tagout procedures and safety works with electrical circuits
- Safely uses ladders, tagging, scaffolding, and lifts
- Selects, maintains, and safely uses rigging, lifting, and hoisting equipment
- Ties knots for hoisting, lifting, and rigging
- Performs hand (crane) signals
- Uses and maintains hand and power tools
- Uses and maintains measuring and leveling tools
- Uses and applies sealants and adhesives
- Uses and maintains refrigeration tools and equipment
- Handles refrigerant and oil according to environmental regulations
- Safely transports refrigerants and oils to transport regulations
- Uses and maintains refrigerant recovery and recycling equipment and cylinders
- Performs refrigerant and oil conversions
- Cuts, bends, fits, and installs refrigeration piping and tubing
