Sprinkler Fitter: Trade Related Skills

- Uses drawings and schematics
- Maintains safe work environment
- Uses personal protective equipment and safety equipment
- Performs work in confined space
- Uses documentation and reference material
- Prepares work site
- Performs layout of systems
- Cuts and bends pipe and tube
- Threads, grooves, and grinds pipe
- Installs plastic and steel pipe, tube, and fittings
- Selects and installs sprinklers and nozzles
- Installs portable extinguishers, sleeves, supports, hangers, and system drainage
- Installs wet and dry pipe systems
- Inspects portable fire extinguishers
- Uses rigging, hoisting, lifting, soldering, and brazing equipment
- Installs fire department connection piping and components
- Uses hand tools, portable and stationary power tools, and access equipment
