Truck and Transport Mechanic: Trade Related Skills

- Maintains safe work environment
- Uses personal protective equipment and safety equipment
- Maintains hand, power, measuring, testing, diagnostic tools, and shop equipment
- Uses hoisting, lifting, cutting, and heating equipment
- Uses documentation and reference materials
- Maintains fluids, lubricants, and coolants
- Services hoses, tubing, fittings, filters, bearings, bushings, and seals
- Uses fasteners, sealing devices, adhesives, and gaskets
- Services base engine and charging systems
- Services lubrication and cooling systems
- Diagnoses and performs servicing and repair of batteries
- Services, diagnoses and repairs tires, wheels, and hubs
- Services, diagnoses, and repairs air systems, brake systems and steering system
- Services, diagnoses, and repairs chassis/frame components, suspensions, and hitches
- Services base engine, lubrication systems, and cooling systems
- Services, diagnoses, and repairs exterior cab, trailer, and hydraulic components
- Repairs charging system
