- Uses personal protective equipment and maintains a safe work environment
- Safely and effectively use and maintain all required tools and equipment
- Perform lock-out and tag-out procedures
- Perform basic calibration of precision measuring instruments
- Read and transfer measurements from drawings
- Interpret basic hand signals, common symbols and markings found on drawings, and basic precision measuring instrument scales
- Install brackets, hangers, fasteners, seismic restrains systems (chains, cables, shock mounts), bonding systems, conductors, cables, and raceways
